


6.0 Image Upload


The Rate Lock system allows the Seller to upload loan-specific diligence related document directly to a loan or to an exception on a loan.

From the **Pipeline** heading, select the **Loan ID** for the loan that requires an image upload.



Once the loan is open, click the **Upload Loan File** button.

Note: Files can only be uploaded to loans that are in the **Rate Lock** and **Registered** status. Once the loan reaches the **Review in Process** status, the **Upload Loan File** button will no longer be available.





Once the Seller has selected the files to upload using the **Click to Select Files** button, the system will ask them to identify the file. The options from the drop-down menu are:

- Appraisal Pre-close appraisal(s).
- Post-Close Post-close loan file





For Appraisals:

- The Seller can upload up to three appraisals (or appraisal related) documents at once.
- Assign each image as "Appraisal".
- Rate Lock will pull them in separately and code them correctly.

For Post-Close Documents:

- Rate Lock is designed to take a single, unsecured PDF as a Post-Close file.
- If the Seller's system is not able to combine documents into one PDF, they can combine multiple documents into a compressed or zipped file for upload.

Once the Seller has selected and labeled the files, click the **Upload Files** button.

Note: The Seller can also upload a Bid Tape (Data Tape) in XLS or XLSX format.



The **Upload Files** screen will appear and, when the file has been uploaded, **COMPLETE** will appear. Click the **OK** button.



The Seller can view the status of the image uploads below the Property Info section of the loan detail screen.
